The Head of Centre is a member of the Association of Heads of Outdoor Education Centres.

### **Membership of National Governing Bodies**

The Centre's teaching staff are members of the national governing bodies appropriate to the instructional / coaching / leadership awards they hold to lead adventurous activities.

These awards are in addition to their professional teaching qualification, which is a pre-requisite in order to be a member of the Centre's teaching team.

Where no National Governing Body Awards exist, they will:

- have undergone in-house training
- been observed leading the activity

and their competence validated as being consistent with the requirements of the Licensing Regulations by the Head of Centre.

### **Adventure Activity Equipment**

Lledr Hall Outdoor Education Centre provides all the specialist equipment required to participate in the Outdoor Adventurous Activities listed above.

All equipment is fit for purpose and is inspected as part of the Lledr Hall Outdoor Education Centre Adventure Activity License.



## **Fire Protection**

All Centre Staff have been trained to 'Workplace fire safety 'standard.

The fire alarm and fire escape doors are tested weekly as part of the group induction fire drill.

The fire system including all extinguishers and detectors are tested annually and under a maintenance contract with Dragon Fire Ltd.
